Some parts of the Ahr valley have been destroyed by the flood disaster 2 years ago. On site you can see and witness the consequences and effects of climate change. That's why we go there, we want to be present with what is. It is a hungry place, we want to listen to it.

Last year in August the first Ecoretreat (Bearing Witness to the Earth) took place in the Rhine lignite mining area. In the spirit of Zen Peacemaker together with Roshi Frank De Waele.

We are also happy that some people from the German Zen Peacemaker community will be there as well as a mindful and very creative filmmaker from the Netherlands. We are curious to see what and whom we will meet and are open to other interested participants: So, this is a warm invitation to walk with us, listen, be in silence and share what is.

Here is the original text of our intention, here you can of course preregister for 2024 if you are interested:

This retreat will be a pilgrimage to the Ahr area in West Germany near the Dutch border. We will visit places connected with the ecological crisis, such as open-cast lignite mines, places in the Ahr valley destroyed by floods years ago, and Büchel air base in the Eifel region, where about 20 nuclear bombs are kept ready for use. We will combine (long distance) walking and public transport. The programme of the retreat, the travels, the food and sleeping accommodations will all not be prepared before the retreat, only rough ideas of where we want to go. For the rest we will trust in our own creativity, co-creation, inventivity and meeting friendly people who will help us find our way. Not knowing, bearing witness and caring will be our tenets and main practices, in the tradition of the Zen Peacemakers founded by Bernie Glassman Roshi. Our approach will be similar to street retreats and bearing witness retreats. Ingredients of the retreat will be visiting ecodharmic places, meeting with people connected to the ecocrises, connecting with nature, meditation and council circles (talking stick circles).

Expected date: spring/summer 2024

Location: Ahrtal and other ecodharmic places in the region

Participants: no minimum, maximum 20

Language: English (although meetings with people can be in German and translated for anyone who needs it)
